Consumer called with a complaint: They repossessed my car, and they did not let me get my stuff out – there was no warning at all! WHY???!!!

When consumer called the business, they responded she had thirty days to come get her things ... but she didn't.

"Shouldn't she have been warned? Shouldn't she be given more time?"

What would you have said??

Everyone needs a little help. That's what we're here for.

Our Nataly received a call on our public lines. A gentleman called to report some phone numbers he considered to be scam numbers. After he heard her accent, he said ... "Sounds like you speak

Spanish." She said, "Yes, I do."

It started:

How do you say, "Thank you" in Spanish. She said "Gracias".

How about "See you later"? She said "Te veo luego"

He said ... "What's wrong with the bagel?"

He said ... How do you say "Have a good day?" She said "Ten un buen dia".

A big smile came across all our faces at BBB, as we heard what started as a scam reporting call ... turn into a Spanish class over the phone!

"Sounds like luego"

Yes, we do it all!

Consumer filed a report on BBB's Scam Tracker website ... Reported that liquor at a particular tavern "didn't taste 'full proof' ... or as advertised". Consumer noted that "As a connoisseur of bourbon and whiskey alike, I often notice subtle differences in the taste of the beverages. Every whiskey I have tried at this establishment has been noticeably softened or smooth. After dining there several times it has yet to change." Consumer suspects the tavern is adding water or some other filler to their bottles of liquor and should be investigated.

BBB NOTE: This could be illegal and might get an establishment shut down. If a consumer suspects a bar is diluting liquor, they should file a complaint with the Ohio Investigative Unit of the Ohio Department of Public Safety. They can also contact the TTB's Market Compliance Office of the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau for information regarding trade practices. Additionally, the consumer can contact the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) or the Federal Trade Commission (FTC).



A Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement, or MEWA, is a self-funded health care option for small employers. MEWAs allow small businesses to join together to purchase health insurance to capitalize on scale, share risk, and offer benefits to their employees outside of the traditional Affordable Care Act (ACA) plan.





Northwest Ohio Business Alliance (NWOBA) and Paramount Health Care partnered to create a self-funded MEWA for businesses.

Who is Eligible?

Qualified employer groups with 1-50 employees, including sole proprietorships, that are in good standing with a participating chamber or the Better Business Bureau are eligible to join the NWOBA MEWA. Employers must be located within Paramount's service area in Ohio to be eligible to apply.

Benefits of a MEWA

- Typically lower rates than the ACA compliant plans
- Multiple plan offerings, including HMO plans and Consumer Driven Health Plans
- Prescription drug benefits including affordability for the member and employer

Member Benefits include:

- MyParamount member portal allows members to electronically receive Explanations of Benefits (EOBs), view claims, check on authorizations, and more.
- ProMedica OnDemand allows for 24/7/365 virtual visits.
- Personal Call Center Representative allows members to request a dedicated representative to speak to every time they call Paramount.
- Ask Paramount, a free nurse line available 24/7/365.

Completion of the temporary authorization provides a third-party administrator (TPA) limited authority to view an employer's payroll and loss experience. By signing the AC-3, the employer grants permission to the BWC to release information to the employer's authorized representative(s). The form allows a TPA to view an employer's information regarding payroll, claims and experience modification.

Attention group rating prospects

- Employers may complete the AC-3 for as many TPAs or group-rating sponsors they feel are necessary to obtain quotes for a group-rating program.
- Group sponsors must notify all current group members if they will not accept them for the next group-rating year. The deadline for this notification is prior to the last business day in October for private employers and prior to the last business day in April for public employers.
- All potential group-rating prospects must have:
 - Active BWC coverage status as of the application deadline;
 - Active coverage from the application deadline through the group rating year;
 - No outstanding balances;
 - Operations similar in nature to the other members of their group.
- Any changes to a group member's policy will affect the group policy. Changes can result in either debits or credits to each of the members.

Note: For complete information on rules for group rating, see Rules 4123-17-61 through 4123-17-68 of the Ohio Administrative Code or your TPA. All group-rating applicants are subject to review by the BWC employer programs unit.

NAVIGATING CREDIT CARD PROCESSING FEES: A GUIDE FOR BUSINESS OWNERS

Accepting credit card payments is a must for business owners in today's economy, but the maze of processing fees can erode profits if left unchecked. Understanding these costs—and why they rise—helps you make smart choices and retain more revenue.



The Basics of Processing Fees

Credit card processing fees come in three main forms: interchange fees, assessment fees, and processor markup fees. Interchange fees, set by card networks like Visa and Mastercard, depend on card type (e.g., rewards cards cost more) and transaction method (in-person vs. online). Assessment fees are smaller charges from the networks for their services. Processor markup fees—flat rates, percentages, or subscriptions—are added by your payment processor. Together, these typically range from 1.5% to 3.5% per transaction, varying by business and provider.



Why Fees Increase

Many merchants see costs creep up over time. Card networks adjust interchange rates annually to offset inflation or operational expenses—Visa and Mastercard, for instance, raised rates in 2023 for post-pandemic recovery. The rise of premium rewards cards, popular with customers, also bumps up interchange fees. Processors may quietly increase markups or tack on extras like PCI compliance fees, often hidden in fine print. Economic factors, such as rising interest rates or supply chain woes, can further drive adjustments.



Managing the Costs

To keep fees in check, review your merchant statement monthly. Dig into the details—interchange, assessment, and processor fees—not just the "effective rate." Compare your rates to industry norms using online tools or competitor quotes. Negotiate with your processor; many will lower markups for loyal clients. Transparent pricing models, like flat rates (e.g., 2.6% + \$0.10 per transaction), simplify budgeting, though they may cost more upfront. Optimize transactions by favoring in-person payments, which often carry lower fees than online ones.

ASK THE EXPERT - FINE TUNE YOUR MARKETING AIM

We all know the correct order of events is "ready, aim, fire." But, sometimes we just can't seem to get the order right. Maybe we think we don't have time to wait so we have to act now or maybe it is too much reliance on gut instinct. No arguing that there are times when "fire" might be the best tactic. However, for the majority of marketing decisions—especially when the cost of a misstep or misread of the market can be costly—taking the time to "aim" is worthwhile.

- Align all stakeholders. It is much easier to achieve success if everyone understands the objectives, believes in the process, and knows what success looks like.
- Inquire. Although your business sense has served you well over the years, you may not have all of the answers or hold all of the insights. Afterall, it is hard for anyone who knows their product to imagine that another person could be oblivious to all of the benefits, or how it works, or where to buy it.
- Mobilize. Be sure the staff is trained, you have enough inventory, and all promotions are coordinated and ready to go. Good
 marketing requires all components of the marketing mix are primed and execution ready.

If you have a business decision to make, listen to the voice of your customers, your value chain, referral sources, or others who can help you understand the evaluation and selection factors used by your market.

- When it is time to advertise, test the ideas first. How else do you really know if the message and the medium used for the communication have meaning to the audience and reach them when and where it matters?
- If you are thinking about offering a product innovation, a new menu item, or enhanced service feature, it might be worth testing that strategy to ensure it is going to have the intended impact. Consumers know what they want to achieve. Ask them how you can help them reach the goal line.
- Thinking that your pricing strategy is not optimal? You need to know what your customers value and what they will pay for that value.

These types of questions can be answered with cost-effective, scientific research. There is a reason why the old adage of "do it right the first time" is still around. It is best to AIM. It is always better to ask rather than make a costly guessing error.

... program, the better it looked. Skilled volunteer arbitrators could examine each dispute and decide if the engine or transmission was really defective, and order GM to do repairs or even buy back the car if it was a "lemon." The FTC was impressed and told GM they would accept BBB arbitration with GM paying the expenses. Even *Consumer Reports Magazine* issued its own evaluation that BBB arbitration was "commendably fair."

So both sides executed a "consent agreement" in Washington which landed on us Wednesday, November 16, 1983. The impact of the FTC designating BBB to handle potentially 26 million national car complaints was staggering. Overnight, for just NW Ohio and SE Michigan, I had to hire four new staffers and recruit more than 40 volunteer arbitrators. The International BBB sent in trainers, and we had multiple arbitrator training classes in the ballroom of the old Downtown Holiday Inn (long gone.) We had to rent several conference rooms to handle all the cases; I think we handled more than 1,000 hearings in the first year alone!

And the outcome? Most consumers loved it! BBB arbitrators ordered their engines or transmissions repaired or replaced fast and at no charge! Many had such serious car problems that they were awarded "buybacks," and GM could not appeal the decisions! The FTC required that all cases be handled in 40 days or less! And if a consumer lost his arbitration, which sometimes happened, he still retained all rights to file a lawsuit against GM anyway. It was a win-win situation for everyone.

The FTC consent agreement of 1983 had a staggering impact on BBB; but we embraced the challenge back then and thousands of consumers saved millions of dollars as a result!

EMAIL MARKETING COMPLIANCE: WHAT SMALL AND MEDIUM-SIZED BUSINESSES NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE CAN-SPAM ACT

In today's digital world, email marketing is a powerful tool for small and medium-sized businesses (SMBs) to connect with customers, promote products, and build brand awareness. However, businesses must navigate certain legal requirements to ensure they are in compliance with the **CAN-SPAM Act** (Controlling the Assault of Non-Solicited Pornography and Marketing Act), a law designed to protect consumers from unwanted emails. Understanding and adhering to these rules is crucial for avoiding hefty penalties and maintaining a positive reputation.

1. Clear Identification of Commercial Emails

One of the primary requirements of the CAN-SPAM Act is that all marketing emails must be **clearly identifiable** as commercial messages. This means your email should have:

- Accurate "From" information: The sender's name must be clear, and it should be easy for recipients to recognize who is sending the email. This helps avoid confusion and ensures transparency.
- Honest subject lines: Your subject line must accurately reflect the content of the email. Deceptive or misleading subject lines, such as those that imply an offer or message that is not actually in the email, are prohibited under the

By following these simple rules, you reduce the chances of your emails being flagged as spam and increase the trust your recipients place in your business. 2. Providing a Clear Opt-Out Mechanism
The opt-out or unsubscribe feature is one of the most important provisions of the CAN-SPAM Act. Every email you send must include a clear and easy way for recipients to

 The unsubscribe option should be simple—a one-click link or clear instructions to opt-out.

unsubscribe from future communications.

- Once a customer requests to opt out, your business must honor their request within 10 business days.
- It's also important to ensure that unsubscribing is free—you cannot charge customers to remove themselves from your email list.

Providing a straightforward opt-out process not only keeps you compliant with the law but also shows that you respect your customers' preferences.

3. Include a Valid Physical Address

Another key requirement of the CAN-SPAM Act is that all marketing emails must include a **valid physical postal address**. This could be your business's street address or a post office box where your business is located. Including this information helps promote transparency and ensures recipients can reach your business if they need to.

4. No False or Misleading Information

The CAN-SPAM Act also prohibits the use of **false or misleading information** in your emails. This includes:

- Misleading the recipient about the sender's identity in the "From" field.
- Using a deceptive subject line that doesn't accurately represent the content of the email.

Being transparent about who you are and what your email contains helps build trust with your audience and ensures compliance with the law.

5. Monitor Third-Party Vendors

If your business works with third-party vendors to send marketing emails, you are still responsible for ensuring that they follow the CAN-SPAM Act's requirements. It's important to choose reputable vendors and regularly monitor their practices to make sure they are also complying with the law. Email is a common way for membership organizations like BBB to keep members informed about programs and benefits, and to communicate helpful information. Even though our members have already consented to get these emails, we use email platforms and vendors that comply with CAN-SPAM.

Why Compliance Matters

The CAN-SPAM Act provides steep penalties for non-compliance—up to \$43,280 per violation. For small businesses that rely on email marketing to engage customers, these fines can quickly add up. By following the requirements outlined above, businesses can avoid legal troubles, protect their reputation, and run more effective email marketing campaigns.

By staying compliant with the CAN-SPAM Act, small and medium-sized businesses can continue to use email marketing to grow their customer base without the risk of costly penalties. And here I thought it was a tariff on Canadian canned meat.
