THINGS TO KNOW



BBB® & American General, LLC. offer these tips to help you make the best decision before starting your improvement project.

Hiring an ethical contractor is the most important step when starting a home improvement project. Consumers should research all options and examine the contractor's former projects. BBB and American General, LLC. offers these tips:

- **Estimates.** When hiring a contractor, get at least three estimates. Ensure contractors have proof of their licensing and insurance. Ask if a permit is required for the project (qualified contractors can acquire any permits before starting).
- **References.** Ask to visit previous jobs and interview their references. Ask customers if the job was completed appropriately, if it was completed on schedule, and if it was on budget. Ask if they would recommend the contractor. In addition, find out if the original estimate was close to the final cost or if the contractor charged unforeseen costs.
- **Payment.** Arrange a payment that requires e a low down-payment and only pays the contractor for work completed to a predetermined timeline. Do not make final payment until the job is finished to your standards. Pay with either a credit card a check, or financing and never pay cash only.
- **Document.** Have a written agreement that clearly includes all of the project details. It should consist of: contact information, payment schedule, estimated completion date, materials being used, material cost, warranties, and any specific promises. Include wording that requires the contractor to clean up the site after completion. Never sign a blank contract and make sure to read the contract thoroughly. Keep at lease one full copy of the agreement after completion in case of issues.


is made public on the website. Students then have 4-6 weeks to promote and market their video through social and traditional marketing channels.

BBB_® Advice on Hiring Contractors Do You Know the Red Flags?

Whether you are looking to have your home windows replaced, new siding installed on your garage, or a pool built for the summer months ahead, it's always important to find a home contractor that you can trust. Better Business Bureau recommends following this smart shopper checklist before choosing a contractor for your home. While there are many trustworthy and reliable

contractors, there are always those unscrupulous few that end up charging too much and doing too little...or nothing at all.

Start With Trust

"When renovating, adding a room, or just doing some much-needed repairs, you want a contractor you can trust. A home improvement job or repair gone-wrong can cost you. A flashy advertisement isn't proof a contractor does quality work. Do your research, check with friends, read reviews and always check with BBB before signing any contract" advises Amie Mitchell, President & CEO of Better Business Bureau serving Eastern Oklahoma. "Be especially wary of doing business with a contractor who solicits business door-to-door. This could mean that the contractor is not from a local, established business and is instead just passing through and trying to scam innocent consumers."

Compare Costs

Be picky and have lots of options. Seek at least three bids from prospective contractors based on the same specifications, materials and labor needed to complete the project. Homeowners should discuss bids in detail with each contractor and ask questions about variations in pricing. The lowest-priced contractor may not be the best.

Are They Bonded/Licensed & Insured?

Verify that contractors are certified and insured. Consumers should ask whether the company is insured against claims covering workers' compensation, property damage, and personal liability in case of accidents and obtain the name of the insurance carrier and call to verify coverage. Ask whether the contractor meets licensing and bonding requirements set by the state, county, or city. Check with local authorities to find out if permits are needed before proceeding with the work. The contractor should be able to obtain any required permits.

Read & Understand Your Contract

Get everything in writing. Ask whether the contractor will provide a lien waiver upon completion of the job. A lien waiver is a statement by the contractor confirming that all suppliers and subcontractors have been paid for their work. Read and understand the contract before signing. Get all verbal promises in writing. Include start and completion dates in the contract.

Remember the rule of thirds and follow it. Pay one third at the start of the project, one third when work is 50 percent completed, and one third after completion.

THINGS TO KNOW

One frequently overlooked aspect of owning a home is the need for a professional tree service. Having trees on your property means sooner or later you will require tree services of some kind, whether it be tree or stump removal, trimming, fertilization, or a consultation with a Certified Arborist concerning treatments for diseased or dying trees. Here are a few tips from your BBB and We B Trees:



- Get at least three written estimates detailing work specifications. Don't base your decision on the lowest estimate. Consider reputation, years of service, and quality of services provided.
- Determine if companies have Certified Arborists on staff; these are tree care professionals with a proven level of knowledge-based competency specific to tree care.
- Meet with company representatives. They should be dressed professionally, be prompt and courteous, and have knowledge of industry standards.
- Ask for proof of proper certifications and insurance coverage. But don't stop there verify that the insurance is valid by calling the listed insurance agent or certifying organization.
- Find out if the tree service is a member of an industry organization such as the International Society
 of Arboriculture (ISA) or the Tree Care Industry Association (TCIA). These organizations ensure
 companies adhere to industry standards, certifications, and insurance requirements, as well as
 evaluate overall business practices.
- Do your research before agreeing to any work. Request a list of references and check them out. If possible, visit previously completed jobs.
- Don't be "stumped" by the leftovers. A professional tree service will possess the necessary tree stump removal equipment.
- Remember, there's more to tree care than just trimming! Your trees are an investment. When properly cared for, they boost curb appeal and property value. Ask a Certified Arborist about services and treatments to maintain the health of your trees, including deep root fertilization.

As a millennial, I take pride in my ability to learn how to do things myself. Famously, millennials use the internet to research how to do things; to that end, we research every purchase, we read reviews, and we enjoy instant gratification. When it comes to a major purchase, such as a house, I find it is difficult to really sift through all the advertisements or misinformation. Far be it for me to hire a realtor and thoroughly question them - no. I want to find out the information on my own.

If you feel similarly, your first step should be finding a mortgage broker. Try searching on bbb.org and read through complaints (if there are any) and customer reviews. Make sure the business has been operating for a decent length of time. Afterall, you must submit a significant amount of personal information to your mortgage company, therefore it is of the utmost importance that you find a legitimate business.

Also, keep in mind that when viewing BBB reports on any business, just

because they have some complaints doesn't mean they are altogether a business you wouldn't want to engage with. Read the complaints! I find that it doesn't necessarily matter what the complaint is about, it's how the business responds to it. Take a rude or flippant response into consideration before engaging with a business. Find a business that responds to a complaint with kindness and concern, with an informative response instead of defensive.

Once you have procured yourself a good, reliable mortgage company, you can begin the arduous process of submitting your life to them via paperwork. Be ready with check stubs and bank statements. But at the end of that paperwork tunnel, there is a letter awaiting you, which will detail how much house you can afford. A pre-approval letter will give you an idea of what price range in which to start your house hunt.

At this point, it is time to find a realtor, to aid you in your hunt. A realtor will be



able to arrange tours of houses in your price range, and will help you search for the perfect place to fit your budget and your tastes. The realtor will work with your mortgage broker to ensure all paperwork is completed. BBB lists realtors and you can do your research on them as well. Make sure you are selecting a knowledgeable person, one that has been around and can help negotiate a deal for you. It is not always the best decision to choose the 'easy' route.

My husband and I have several realtor friends and our previous landlord is a realtor. We had to really consider why we were choosing a specific person to be our realtor, we wanted to make sure the person we chose would best suit our needs. As first time home buyers, we wanted a realtor that was experienced and familiar with all the regulations and contracts. It is good to have a realtor that will go to bat for you in negotiations.

Millennials encompass a huge group of active consumers with a massive impact on the economy. Although millennials are known to research anything and everything on the internet, BBB is an underused tool. BBB is a neutral, third-party, that reports the facts. BBB facilitates complaint conciliation for consumers, for free, in case a dispute with a business arises.

BBB is also a review platform, wherein consumers can submit their customer experiences for others to view. Keep this in mind next time you shop online or take the huge leap into homeownership. You may want to check bbb.org to make sure the home inspection company you use is a good one, or the termite inspector, or realtor, or mortgage broker. BBB reports on them all!



6 BBB Tips for Choosing a Real Estate Agent or Broker

uying and selling a home is a major decision, so be sure to choose a real estate agent who will guide you through the process. Look for an agent or broker who is experienced,

agent or broker who is experienced, knowledgeable about your housing market, and always act in your best interest. Use these tips as a guide:

1. Ask for Referrals

Ask friends and family members who have recently bought or sold their home for recommendations. Ask if they were satisfied with their experience and if they would use the agent or company in the future. Be sure to ask if there are agents or companies to avoid.

2. Meet with Candidates

Once you have assembled at least four prospective agents, schedule a time to meet with them in person. If you are selling your home, each agent should make a listing presentation. This presentation allows you to become familiar with their background, marketing plan, and market analysis, which includes information about similar houses in your area that have recently sold. Many agents assemble a team to support them, which can include less experienced agents and/or non-agents working together to market your property. Think about whether you would be more comfortable working with a solo agent or a team, as they have different strengths. Ask the agent to provide a list of references who have previously used their services to buy or sell similar types of properties.

3. Ask the Right Questions

Make sure to find out how long the agent has been practicing, how many transactions they've done in the past year, and when they are available. Agents who have more transactions and years of experience will be familiar with guiding you through the buying or selling process and handling any problems that may crop up. If you work a 9-5 job, you will need to choose a real estate agent who is available weekends and evenings. And be sure your agent is familiar with your area.

4. Pick an Agent Who Acts in Your Best Interest

Whether you are buying or selling a home, be sure to choose an exclusive agent based on your role. This way the agent will act in your best interest for the sale. Also, ask whether your agent is a REALTOR®. This means they are a member of the National Association of REALTOR® (NAR) and are held to a specific code of ethics while practicing real estate.

5. Discuss Compensation

Usually agents are compensated through commission. The commission fee is usually 5 to 7 percent of the selling price, but it can vary from area to area. The percentage of the commission fee can sometimes be negotiated depending on the housing market. The agent receives commission regardless of who finds the buyer but receives no commission if the property doesn't sell. The commission is usually divided evenly between the listing agent and the buyer's agent.

6. Carefully Read the Contract

Do not choose a real estate agent who pressures you to sign documents immediately. Carefully and completely read the documents and make sure the agent clearly answers any of your questions. If you are selling your home, usually you sign a contract granting the agent exclusive rights to sell your property within a period of time. Make sure to ask about the length of that period of time.

THINGS TO KNOW

Oklahoma's mostly mild winters and extended growing season allows homeowners to support an ample garden. Whether you want a healthy green lawn, flowerbeds, or a generous vegetable garden, knowing when and how to care for these can be confusing and time-consuming. BBB and Holland Landscape, LLC, offer a few tips to help navigate the planting seasons.

In most cases, the products that are used for controlling weeds and pests are best left to certified professionals who are specifically trained to ensure safety for the environment and your family. Here are a few tips for maintain your landscape.

January through February is the ideal time to spray Bermuda lawns for grassy green weeds. As temperatures rise, Bermuda comes out of dormancy, so the cooler temperatures are the best time to treat pesky weeds.

February through March is the best time to apply a pre-emergence weed killer to lawn and landscape beds. This is also the best time to trim Liriopi, also known as monkey grass or lilyturf, and fountain grasses, Crapemyrtle, and any winter kill on shrubs. For fescue lawns, February through March is the time to fertilize.

Most Oklahoma variety Azaleas bloom early to mid-April; you want to trim Azaleas after blooming and fertilize with Azalea food. April to May is best to fertilize all plantings, Bermuda, and Zoysia grasses. After mid-April, it's time to plant those Spring flowers! Plant annual bedding plants, perennials, summer flowering bulbs, and annual flower seeds after the danger of frost. Remember to add a controlled-release fertilizer.

You'll want to treat lawns for broadleaf and grassy weeds during the summer months of June and July, as well as fertilize lawns with a higher nitrogen fertilizer to maintain the green color of your yard. It is not recommended to trim Azaleas after July 4th, and if you find Lace bugs, treat with a spray pesticide. As the summer comes to an end, use weed preventer on landscape beds, mulch beds to protect from the Indian summer months and water to achieve 1-inch of rain per week.

Preparing for the winter months, September through October, fertilize Bermuda lawns with winterizing fertilizer. It is also the time to seed and fertilize Fescue lawns and apply weed preventer to Bermuda, Zoysia, and established Fescue lawns. You will want to avoid any areas you intend to seed. For fall colors in your garden, these months are the time to plant flowers such as pansies, chrysanthemums, flowering kale. All will provide your landscape with color well after the first frost.


