BBB's Ethics Student Video Contest is seeking students to engage on topics of TRUST & ETHICS. Student are encouraged to work with guidance from parents and teachers, to create a 30-60 second video that tells a story about:

- BBB History and Traditions
- BBB's Core Values
- The Importance of BBB's Mission today and in the future.
- BBB Services

Judges want to see a creative, clever or inspiring take on annual theme centered on ethical dilemmas.

Content Guidelines

AWARDS VIDEO CONTEST



Finalists will be recognized during our annual Torch Awards for Ethics event. The total amount awarded will be \$4,000.00.

- First Place \$2,000.00
- Second Place \$1,500.00
- Third Place \$500.00

The total score will be used to rank entries and identify the first, second and third place winners. Any entries with tied scores in the top five will be submitted to judges to be scored again in comparison to each other as a tiebreaker.

Entries must be submitted by April 30, 2023 via the one entry as described below. Finalist will be notified by email at the beginning of May. The video will be potentially used in BBB media and all entries will become the property o BBB Serving Southern Arizona.

Participating schools are eligible for student submission for the 2022/2023 school year. You will need to complete the following forms by April 30, 2023:

- Ethics Video Contest Registration Form
- Waiver & Parental Consent Agreement Disclosure of COPPA Compliance
- Terms & Conditions and Media Release Form
- Complete the Student Checklist

Getting Started

VIDEO REQUIREMENTS



In order to qualify for judging, the video submission must adhere to the following specifications:

- Entries must be 30-60 seconds in duration
- Should you choose to shoot your video with a phone camera, videos must be shot in "landscape mode" (horizontally). Vertical videos will be disqualified from consideration.
- Music within the video must be either free domain or rights must be owed by the student.
- Video files shoud be exported, saved and submitted in MP4 format via WeTransfer (more information on how to do this on the video submission page).
- Video file submissions MUST be labeled correctly. The file name should include BBBVideo2023, student name. Example: BBBVideo2023_TaylorJones.mp4. This file must be no larger than 2GB in size.
- All video entries should begin with an introduction that includes your name and school name (Not included in the 30-60 second timeframe).
- Videos should be well-lit and contain clear-sounding audio. While it is not expected for you to use expensive or professional equipment, it is required that your face be clearly visible and your voice easily understood in the recording.
- Evaluation of the video entries and awarding of the awards will be accomplished by a panel of judges from businesses, colleges/universities, and non-profit organizations are member or partners of the BBB Serving Southern Arizona. Additional judging will be conducted by the BBB's staff.

Judging Criteria

- Ethics Video Contest Registration Form
- Waiver & Parental Consent Agreement Disclosure of COPPA Compliance
- Terms & Conditions and Media Release Form
- Complete the Student Checklist
- Determine the topic you want your video to be about. How can you deliver your message clearly in 30-60 seconds?
- Make sure your theme is BBB related and revolves around TRUST & ETHICS.
- Outline your video with the Judging Criteria in mind.
- If using any third-party material, you must provide proper licensing. Consider using royalty free music and materials.
- If shooting video with phone camera, video must be in landscape mode (horizontally).
- Use the first portion of your video to identify yourself and your current school (not included in the 60 or less seconds)
- Make sure your video is in ,MP4 format. If you are having trouble with formatting visit our content page.
- Make sure your video is under 2 GB in size.
- Label your video file correctly.
- Submit your video by April 16. 2023 on our Video
 Submission Page.

- January 10, 2023 Registration Opens
- January 10 April 16 Video submissions can be uploaded at any time during this time frame along with or after the forms have been submitted. Videos approved by teachers may be uploaded or sent by students.
- April 30, 2023 Registration Ends. Submissions MUST be received by
 11:59 pm (no exceptions). All entries without forms will be disqualified.
- May 1, 2023 Videos will be send to judges for review.
- o may 5, 2023 BBB notifies teachers and students of the finalists
- May 19, 2023 Winners announced the the Torch Awards for Ethics event.
 - All finalist will receive two tickets to attend the event.
 - Additional tickets are available for purchase at a discounted price.
